## COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING

Chapter 106, Article V, Section 106 of the City of Castroville Code of Ordinances prohibits parking of Commercial Motor Vehicles in certain areas.

- ◆ Commercial Motor Vehicles are defined as a motor vehicle or combination of motor vehicles used to transport passengers or property that: weighs more than 26,000 pounds; is designed to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver; or is transporting hazardous materials and is required to be placarded under 49 C.F.R. part 172, Subpart F.
- ◆ Parking is prohibited in the right-of-way at: 800 Block of Paris Street between Mexico and Naples Streets; 1200 Block of Naples Street between Paris Street and US Highway 90
- ◆ There is no overnight parking by commercial motor vehicles allowed on Houston Square, including the surrounding streets of Madrid, Lorenzo, Paris, and Angelo. Removal of unauthorized vehicles parked in violation will be at the expense of the owner or operator of the vehicle.
- ◆ Commercial vehicles are not allowed to park in residential areas beyond 30 minutes.
- ◆ On street parking of a commercial vehicle on either side of the street of Country Lane, Meadow Drive, Hollow Drive, or Brook Street is prohibited on or after 8:00 pm – 6:00 am.

## CASTROVILLE CCR REPORTS

A CCR (Consumer Confidence Report) is an annual water quality report delivered by community water systems to their customers. The CCR includes information on source water, the levels of detected contaminants, and compliance with drinking water rules.
