Councilmember Tschirhart felt city services, beauty of old town and Medina River was important. Councilmember Martinez felt quality of life, good schools, and open spaces were important. Councilmember King felt preserving the community and treating people like family and camaraderie was important. Councilmember Dyer felt respect for others was important. Councilmember Carey felt integrity, truth, and competency was important.
