Camp Rules and Consequences

Castroville Public Library's 2019 Summer Camps

It is the goal of the Jr. Friends of the Library and library staff to provide campers with a fun, enriching, and safe camp experience. In order to make this happen, campers must be willing to follow these rules:

1. Participate in all activities.
2. Be courteous and respectful to your fellow campers, camp leaders, library staff, and volunteers.
3. Camps will be held in various locations. Respect these places.
4. Clean up after yourself.
5. Use your indoor voice when necessary.
6. Stay with the group.
7. Leave all electronic devices at home.

Consequences

1. Campers behaving unacceptably will receive a recorded demerit.
2. Failure to adjust behavior will result in another demerit.
3. At three demerits, you will be sent home.
4. If you are sent home a second time, you will not be allowed to return to the current camp or any subsequent camp. Refunds will not be given.
5. Certain behaviors will not be tolerated and will result in immediate and permanent expulsion from camps. These include but aren't limited to: fighting, using hateful or offensive language, bullying, stealing from the library or other campers, defacing camp venue property.
